



Advanced Scientific Application of Complex Herbal Remedy in Electro-Homeopathy

Abstract

The basic physiological axiom of Electro-Homeopathy (EH) states that "Life is in Blood and Lymph". Whenever the purity of blood or lymph or both is deviated by the pathogenic attack, the disease is created in human health. For faster recovery of the complex human body, 38 complex herbal medicines were invented by Count Cesar Mattei using Synergic mixture of *Spagyrics* of 114 selected plants. Considering the active principles of the constituting plants, the remedies are classified into nine groups. Applying suitable organ-specific EH complex remedy quickly achieves the normal state of blood and lymph by extinguishing pathogens using regenerated T and B lymphocytes. Essentially, the damaged immunity is recovered. Count Cesar Mattei is clinically tested and guided to use suitable organ-specific remedies for basic recovery. The groups of specific remedies and their medicinal properties have been precisely enlisted in various tables at subsequent section. To quickly achieve, a global and complete cure, Mattei advised to use of two or more remedies in alternation and succession. Accordingly, a scientifically designed table has been presented, in the result section, consisting of a set of Complex Remedies essentially needed for affected organs along with those remedies useful for the associated organs for successful recovery. Besides the affected organ, the associated organs and systems have been scientifically taken into consideration in the table. The set of remedies enlisted for clinical practice, includes general constitutional remedies, special comprehensive remedies to enhance the information of medicine propagation and recovery and, lastly, organ stimulant liquid electricity.

1. Introduction

In 1865, Count Cesar Mattei (C. C. Mattei), an Italian herbalist, invented Electro-Homeopathy (EH). A unique physiological law, "Life is in Blood and Lymph" made EH a safe and extremely efficient scientific medical system¹⁻⁷. Any imbalance or irregularity in either lymph or blood or both creates a disease in humans. A healthy homeostasis condition is maintained at a healthy condition of blood and lymph in health. EH treatment restores such a condition in the human system that does not allow any pathogen to reside inside the body for a long period.

Medical treatments, using the active principle of plants, have been continued from ancient ages. Plants had been used alone or as combined bulk materials. Homoeopathy Medical Treatment was invented by Sir Samuel Hahnemann. The essences containing the medicinal properties of a singular plant, element or compound are used, containing the active principles or medicinal properties of their own. Substantial research has been carried out on herbal and Homoeopathy medical science, which are referred to in subsequent sections⁸⁻²⁵.

However, during the nineteenth century, C. C. Mattie's invention was based on a unique medical treatment method using complex remedies, each containing the active principle of *Spagyric* extract of multiple plants and herbs. Count also stated that

EH remedy can automatically, "Cover and Control" the affected organs^{1,2}. According to C. C. Mattei, a globally healthy balanced condition of cells and tissues, organs and systems of human health can uniquely be obtained using a suitable set of complex remedies. During this process, the EH remedy regenerates the lymphocytes present inside the lymph vessels, get regenerated to detect and destroy the pathogens. The waste product or toxin thus produced is expelled quickly through the excretory organs and system. For this purpose, an essentially suitable combination of EH complex medicinal support becomes essential not only to maintain the density of the healthy lymphocyte appropriate to destroy the pathogen, but also to provide support to the loaded excretory system. Hence, an application of sets of scientifically prepared herbal remedies enables the treatment process extremely efficient. Nine groups of EH complex remedies consisting of Mattei's defined 38 remedies have been precisely given in various tables in the Materials and Method section of the text. The medicinal properties have been precisely written in the tables. The active principles of 114 medicinal plants have been presented elsewhere⁴. To obtain, faster and complete recovery, Mattei advised to use of two or more complex remedies in alternation and succession. Hence, a scientifically designed table, consisting of a set of Complex Remedies essentially needed for affected organs along with those remedies useful for the associated organs for successful recovery, has been presented in the result section of the text. The associated organs and systems are scientifically taken into consideration.

EH remedies do not directly kill pathogens. But it creates a balanced condition of blood and lymph, to regenerate and restore the inherent immune system. This process regenerates lymphocytes. The regenerated T and B lymphocytes detect and kill pathogens, at the lymph nodes positioned inside lymph vessels⁴. The finer selection of sets of complex remedies is easily obtained by using various groups of suitable group members among the group of remedies. In EH, complex medicines simultaneously heal both the affected organ and systems that are essentially helpful for faster recovery, e.g., Lymph flow, Blood circulatory system, nerve stimulation, tissue stimulation, etc, as illustrated in the subsequent sections. Hence, it effectively causes, an all-round global system recovery during the healing

process. This is the most vital cause of extremely fast electrical pulse-like recovery in EH treatment.

It may also be mentioned, that the special preparation method used for preparing essential complex remedies is another important area of Electro-Homoeopathy. "Cohobation" is the alchemical process for the preparation of EH remedy. The Spagyric essences are prepared by the "Cohobation" method to collect the useful energy available from the plant. Fermentation, distillation and incineration are the steps followed in the preparation process. The Spagyric preparation method has been presented elsewhere 26-30. The poisonous and harmful components of the plants are removed at the primary step of the Spagyric preparation. The trace element analysis of the harmful components and the studies on the useful functional groups present in the remedy had been carried out and reported elsewhere 31-35.

In EH, faster propagation of small medicinal particles takes place through the tissues, in comparison to that of bulk remedies^{6,30-35}. EH remedies are administered at measured doses of a specific dilution. The oral application of EH remedies is conventionally popular but shows excellent results in some cases of external application³⁶⁻⁴⁶.

The other finer parameters play important roles in faster and more miraculous recovery depending upon the selection of the doses of complex medicine based on the constitution of the patient, the polarity of the diseased organ and the environmental conditions. The polarity is determined by the imbalance of environmental electromagnetic force. In healthy conditions, the complex human body maintains homeostasis by balancing internal force and OD force¹⁻⁶.

2. Materials and Methods

2.1 C C Mattei's Fundamental Complex Electro-Homeopathic Remedies

C C Mattei invented Electro-Homeopathic remedies by synergic mixing of selected herbal *Spagyric* essences at finite proportions⁴. Essences are extracted from 114 plants and herbs using the process of successive fermentation followed by Distillation and incineration^{4,26-30}. The output so obtained at various stages is mixed to get the resultant product with maximum available energy from plants and herbs. *Cohobation* is the complete process of fragmentation and unification of the products available at various

stages. During this process, the harmful components are eliminated to make the medicine efficient and safe. Mattei invented thirty-eight (38) exclusive fundamental organ-specific complex remedies, which were extended to sixty (60) by his followers^{36,37}. Scrofoloso, Canceroso, Angioitico, Febrifugo, Linfatico, Pettorale, Vermifugo, Venereo along with five Liquid Electricity, Lassativo (S-Lass) and Aqua PerlaPelle (APP) are classified into nine groups of Mattei's Remedies^{37,38}.

2.2 Basic Studies on Various Groups of Specific Organ-Based Complex Remedies

Basic studies have been carried out on the groups of Mattei's Electro-Homeopathic fundamental complex remedies,

pointing towards the effectiveness of each Remedy on Specific Organs and Diseases enlisted in the tables. The precise studies of the appropriate member in a group of remedies have been indicated in the Tables. This study is based on the medicinal properties and morphologies of each constituting plant and has been enlisted in various Tables (1-8) and Tables (9-15), presented inside the text. Moreover, Mattei's selection of a specific remedy for the treatment of a diseased organ depends upon the resultant medicinal properties of the constituting plants and herbs. It is evident, that all the groups contain some specified common plants followed by several individual plants. A study on the active principles and medicinal properties of the constituting plants, reveals that the common

set of plants takes care of the affected organ and the individual plants work for the faster propagation of the remedy towards the affected organ. The physiological and medicinal properties of the individual second set of herbal constituents are exactly suitable to quickly reach the diseased organ. The propagation of the remedies becomes faster towards the diseased organ due to the resultant physiological properties of the individual set of plants. Hence, the faster recovery depends upon the suitable selection of both sets of remedies. The recovery process becomes faster as, according to physiological law, a diseased organ is more sensitive towards the appropriate remedy, i.e., the affinity for the appropriate remedy is higher for the diseased organ^{1,2,4,39-42}. Appropriate Tables containing all the remedies needed for various groups have been designed here, considering their physiological and medicinal properties.

2.2.1 Scrofoloso Group

The *Scrofoloso* group contains twelve (12) remedies (S1-S12), out of which eight (S1-S3, S5, S6, S10-S12) are basic remedies and the remaining are mixed. Here, the initial five plants are common and the remaining are organ-specific plants^{47,48} (Table 1). *Scrofoloso* remedies work to purify lymph enhancing the circulation of lymph considering their internal or external assimilation administrated by the state of the Gastro-Intestinal (GI) canal with a glandular appendage, associated tissues and organs. The metabolic process is assisted by

these remedies considering the favorable physiological properties of constituting plants. *Scrofoloso* are immensely helpful for various gastrointestinal organs and tissues of the system. The remarkable landmark on the universal remedial effectiveness of Scrofoloso10 was achieved during a pandemic in Japan. Henceforth, *Scrofoloso10* is coined as *Giappone* in Japan^{1,3,38}.

2.2.2 Angioitico Group

The *Angioitico* group of remedies (A1-A3) are extremely useful for physiological properties related to the heart and the components of the blood circulatory system. The components are blood, blood vessels, arteries, veins, capillaries etc. *Angioitico* are, also indirectly, effective as a consequence of some problems of the lymphatic system. *Angioitico* purifies the blood and enhances the flow of blood. The medicinal properties of the remedies depend upon the active principles of the constituting plants. This group contain three common and other specific plants (Table 2).

2.2.3 Canceroso Group

This group contain ten (10) (C1-C6 and C10, C13, C15, C17) remedies, that are related to various physiological functions of tissues with related systems. *Canceroso* group of remedies may be treated as the extended category of *Scrofoloso* group. The basic difference between them is the efficacy of *Canceroso* remedies that starting where the effectiveness of *Scrofoloso* remedies

diminishes due to chronic degeneration of cells takes place. *Canceroso* remedies are extremely useful in cases, where the effectiveness of *Scrofoloso* remedies decay. It happens when any organ or organized tissue

undergoes degeneration. *Canceroso* is called the tissue remedy, acting on cellular construction, prohibiting chronic degeneration. The group contain four common plants and the remaining are specific (Table 3).

2.2.4 Pettorale Group

Pettorale have four (P1-P4) fundamental medicines, out of total nine (P1-P9). Remaining's are prepared by mixing the fundamentals in finite proportions (Table 4). This group of remedies work for the respiratory system, consisting of trachea, bronchi, respiratory bronchioles alveolar sac and Ear, Nose and Throat (ENT). Pettorale remedies are made of six common plants mixed in various proportions to execute respective functional activities.

2.2.5 Febrifugo Group (F1-F2)

This group contain two members (F1and F2). Febrifugo act on the nervous system to rectify and remove weakness, enhancing the efficacy of other remedies used in combination. Febrifugo can cure all categories of fevers. The remedies are selected on the consideration of various physiological functions of organs, relating to the medicinal properties of constituting plants. Febrifugo contain eight common plants and one each specific plant (Table 5).

2.2.6 *Vermifugo Group (Ver1 and Ver2)*

This group of remedies contain two remedies (Verl and Ver2). They act as antigerm and ante- parasitic infections. *Vermifugos* remedies can cure intestine and other parts of organs affected by various worms. *Vermifugos* show excellent remedial effect on mucous membrane, as an anti-parasitic medicine used in combination to other medicines. *Vermifugos* have four common plants and three individual each (Table 6).

2.2.7 Linfatico Group (L1)

Linfatico Group contains single member (L1). It acts on lymph, lymph glands and blood. The action of *Linfatico* starts at the moment the food turns into living lymph. L1 influences the white blood corpuscles while *Scrofoloso* act more immediately on the organ that produces it. Hence, the effect of this remedy extends up to blood and the course of the blood^{37,38}. This group contains only one remedy (Table 7). Resultant medicinal action

of L1 on Lymph gland, Salivary gland, Respiratory tract, GI tract.

2.2.8 *Venereo* (*Ven 1*)

Venereo group has a single remedy (Ven 1). The remedy acts as an anti-germ, anti-venereal, and anti-viral remedy. It also efficiently works to cure genetic diseases. Venereo exhibits an excellent medicinal effect on the skin, joints, genital and urinary organs, respiratory tract, G.I.T etc. The uses of the remedy depend upon the Active Principles of constituting special plants and herbs (Table 8).

2.2.9 Liquid Electroids (Liquid Remedy): Five Liquid Electric Fluids or Electricity (W E, G E, Y E, R E, B E) and Lassativo (S-Lass) and Aqua Perla Pelle (APP) or Water of skin

2.2.9.1 White Electricity (WE)

Sixteen plants' essences are mixed to form *White Electricity*. After *cohobation*, sixteen plants' essences are mixed in finite parts to form a complex remedy called WE (Table 9). *White Electricity* exhibits neutral properties in combined action and acts on both sensory and motor nerves, the Gastrointestinal Tract (GIT),

respiratory tract, pit of the stomach (Solar plexus), excretory system, skin etc.

2.2.9.2 Green Electricity (GE)

Essence of Eight plants are present in the *Green Electricity*. After *cohobation*, the plant's essences are mixed in a finite part to form *GE*, a complex remedy (Table 10). The resultant medicinal properties show that *GE* prohibits cell damage and abnormal cell growth. It bears anti-cancerous properties acting on the cellular level. *GE* enhance the venous system by curing chronic arthritic diseases. *GE* is found to work nicely on the sensory nerve, cell membrane and nucleus of cells, glands and skin etc.

2.2.9.3 Blue Electricity (BE)

Seven plant's essence is mixed to form *Blue Electricity* (Table 11). After cohobation, all plant's essences are

mixed at finite parts to form BE complex remedy. BE acts on the arterial and venous systems. The synergic action of the essences acts on the intestine, liver, and kidney. BE acts nicely on the blood circulatory system using the *Angioitico* group of remedies. BE works on motor nerves showing positive in action. It acts on the blood vessels, capillary system and heart muscle. Moreover, it remarkably acts on the digestive system and respiratory systems. Hence, BE has a stimulant effect on the whole circulatory system of blood. In diluted conditions, BE tranquillity the overstimulated organs.

2.2.9.4 Yellow Electricity (YE)

After *Cohobation*, specified parts of essences from five plants are mixed to prepare *Yellow Electricity* (Table 12). It acts nicely on the blood circulatory system through blood vessels and capillaries with the *Angioitico* group of remedies. YE acts on motor nerves to show positive

action. The synergetic action of the essence in YE acts on the digestive system, respiratory system, excretory organ, intestine, liver, kidney, sensory nerve and ovary etc. YE is extremely effective on small parts/organs e.g.,

Blood vessels, Capillaries, Heart muscle, gallbladder etc. It relaxes muscular or nervous tension diminishing organic pressure and excitement. Due to exhibiting negative action, YE influences the sensory nerve

stimulation of the organ by varying the dilution. YE increases the activity of the *Vermifugo* group to work as an anti-parasitic remedy. YE acts as an anti-germ and is also effective in the positive part of the body.

2.2.9.5 Red Electricity (RE)

Five plant's essence is present in *Red Electricity*. After *Cohobation*, all plant's essences are mixed at a fixed proportion to form a complex remedy RE (Table 13). The synergetic action of the essence acts on the nervous system, connective tissue, and circulating organs. RE increases blood circulation for arterial and nerve stimulation enhancing the vitality of the human body. RE positively acts to improving the motor nerve stimulation of the organ. It enhances the activity of *Scrofoloso's* group of remedies to work as a pain killer. As RE is a useful nerve stimulant for organs, it is anti-arthritic and Bronchial and also anti-asthmatic. It is useful in both Organic and *Scrofoloso* remedy. Hence, RE is effective in the nervous system, kidney, respiratory system, joints, etc.

2.2.9.6 Lassativo (S-Lass)

Three plants are present in the remedy *S-Lass* (Table 14). The medicinal properties of the plant *Aloe capensis* act on the Vagus nerve. *S-Lass* is an excellent herbal laxative

liquid that acts as an anti-constipation medicine. The synergetic physiological action of the three plants acts on digestive organs enhancing its supply system. Hence the remedy controls the secretion of digestive juice, essentially needed to control constipation. It is also used for digestive disorders during the menstrual cycle of women.

2.2.9.7 AQUA PERLE PELLE (APP) water for skin

Eight plants are present in the remedy *APP* (Table 15). The resultant active principle of the plants works in the *APP*. *APP* nourishes the body's skin like cosmetics to keep it fresh and smooth.

Thirty-eight of Mattei's original complex EH remedies discussed above are included in nine individual groups. Mattei's followers extended the remedies up to 60 complex remedies mixing original remedies in fixed proportions. Such extended remedies have been presented by various authors in their books^{36-38, 43-46}.

3. Results and Discussions

3.1 Mattei's Guideline to Use Two or More Complex Remedies Simultaneously

To facilitate successful medicinal practice, C.C. Mattei scientifically justified and clinically achieved the procedure

to use two or more complex remedies for faster recovery using complex remedies¹. He delivered basic treatment guidelines for nine groups of complex remedies e.g., *Scrofoloso, Angioitico, Canceroso, Febrifugo, Vermifugo, Venereo, Pettorale, Linfatico* and *Liquid Electricity*. The *Scrofoloso, Angioitico* and *Canceroso* groups are justified as the constitutional remedy as they are involved in curing the constituents of the body, e.g., lymph, blood and tissue. The rest of the groups fall under special action but are very comprehensive groups as they are not used to cure every disease, except in special conditions of the diseased organ. The rest of the two groups fall under very special and liquid remedies¹.

To obtain, faster and complete recovery, Mattei advised to use of multiple complex remedies in alternation and succession¹. Hence, to follow the inventor's message, a scientifically designed table has been presented here in Table 16. The Table contains a set of Complex Remedies essentially needed for affected organs along with those remedies useful for the successful recovery of associated organs. Along with, the affected organ, the associated organs and systems are scientifically taken into consideration. The set of remedies enlisted in clinical practice, includes the constitutional remedy, special action comprehensive remedy, very special and liquid remedies¹.

3.2 Discussions

The extremely complex human body consists of innumerable constituents and organs. Healthy organs work in harmony. Blood and lymph are two categories of vital fluids flowing through a large number of capillaries and vessels in the body. Blood is a kind of unique and fast-circulating fluid connective tissue in the body. Blood contains red blood cells, white blood cells, blood

platelets and plasma. Blood transports nourishment, hormones, enzymes, and respiratory gases in various parts of the body. Blood interacts with acids and bases to regulate body temperature and pH level. Lymph is a kind of colourless fluid tissue consisting of lymphocytes, plasma and platelets. This part of the lymphatic system is available in lymphatic vessels. Lymph plays a vital role in transporting white blood cells towards lymph nodes where the pathogens are usually identified and destroyed. Lymph, a non-circulating moving fluid, removes toxins and unwanted waste materials from the body to maintain a balanced healthy condition in the human body. Basically, Lymph and blood are the vital components of the immune system. Hence, EH treatment rejuvenates the immune system by the treatment of lymph and blood ^{49,50}.

Blood and lymph belong to two separate systems of circulation and also flow through separate sets of vessels. But they have their common origin in the laboratory of digestion, where, in the storehouse and the shop of the whole body, all the materials necessary for the maintenance of life and health are prepared and receive their first start in the organization mechanism. Therefore, diseases of the lymph may be, usually mixed with disorders of the blood. Hence, the necessity of frequent resorting to two or more remedies in alternation or succession, to attain a complete cure. To obtain an electric pulse like faster and complete recovery of human health, C. C. Mattei progressed further to use two or more sets of complex remedies in alternation and succession^{1,2}.

For faster and complete recovery, scientifically chosen sets essentially consist of remedies with (1) A Constitutional set including tissue remedy, (2) A Special comprehensive with nerve stimulant, (3)

General Lymph circulation remedy and (4) Liquid electricity for efficient activation of remedies. Moreover, very often, the need arises for an auxiliary set to support the gastrointestinal and executive system for quick removal of waste materials. Hence, such sets of remedies are essential for successful clinical practice. Correlating with the successful clinical practices, the sets of remedies have been designed here in Table 16. Sets of such successful remedies have been used to cure COVID-19 patients in the recent past³⁹⁻⁴².

C.C. Mattei mentioned that his complex remedies follow, the "Physiological law of selection, assimilation and relation"^{1,51-55}. He also pointed out that "The

useful active substances are appropriated and absorbed by the diseased organs, but the useless and aliening substances are rejected"¹⁻⁴. Hence, during using properly chosen complex sets of remedies, "The affected organ automatically selects and assimilates the remedy until its final recovery". In the total process, the remaining attenuated parts of the remedy are absorbed by other affected tissues or organs, at the instances¹.

Any sick organ or system requires the recovery of the following constituents as shown at the top of the column followed by the remedies in the corresponding rows¹⁻⁶. But for non-pathogenic illness, the inapplicable remedies will not be applied.

4. Conclusion

C.C. Mattei invented Electro-Homeopathy to obey his physiological law "Life is in Blood and Lymph". He also invented thirty-eight original Complex Remedy to achieve a healthy balance between Blood and Lymph i.e., a "Homeostasis" situation. Spagyric essences of selected medicinal plants are synergically mixed to prepare EH remedies. Such medicinal plants contain active principles of their own. The pathogens are identified, trapped inside and demolished by energetic T and B lymphocytes, during travelling through the lymphatic vessels. The excretory organ removes toxins as a waste product. Hence, the damaged immune system is rejuvenated. Mattei's original remedies are divided into nine groups, the properties of which are specified through fifteen tables in the materials section of the text. The names of the remedies, appropriate for organs and diseases have been tabulated there. The parts of the constituting plants are precisely presented in the tables.

Mattei's guideline to use two or more selected complex remedies in alternation and succession for quick recovery encouraged the authors to scientifically design a table considering all the related parameters. Here, essentially, the remedies correspond to the affected organ along with the associated helping organ, to enhance the recovery process. The damaged immune system is quickly recovered by EH remedy. The recovery

of injured inherent immune system brands Electro-Homeopathy a comprehensive medical system, valid for all diseases^{1-4,39,40}.

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
